



Customer Agreement Additional Terms Attachment

Software as a Service (SaaS)

The provisions of this Additional Terms Attachment are in addition to and prevail over the General Terms of the Dynamix Group Customer Agreement for sales of a software as a service or a cloud service. Capitalized terms are defined in the General Terms of the Dynamix Group Customer Agreement or in Section 6 of this Attachment.

1. Terms of Sale

SaaS items are provided under their Terms of Use during the Subscription Period as specified in the Order Document and Customer agrees to pay the price as shown. Customer's acceptance of the Order Document confirms Customer's acceptance of the applicable Terms of Use for each SaaS item listed.

2. Overage Charges

The SaaS OEM interface may allow Customer to provision additional SaaS in excess of Customer's Entitlement. If Customer's actual usage of SaaS during the Subscription Period exceeds the Entitlement, then Customer may be billed overage charges as described in the SaaS Terms of Use and agrees to pay for such overage charges.

3. Contract Period Commitment

Unless allowed by the Terms of Use, Customer is committed to pay for SaaS for the entire Subscription Period, and Entitlement can be increased but cannot be cancelled or reduced during the Subscription Period.

4. Renewal Options

SaaS will renew as specified in the Order Document, or if unspecified, SaaS will autorenew. Customer may terminate an expiring SaaS Subscription Period by giving written notice at least ninety (90) days prior to the expiration date.

5. Modification Date

Dynamix last modified these Additional Terms on July 1, 2019.

6. Definitions

Charge Metric is the specific unit of measure for each SaaS item.

Entitlement is the authorized level of usage for each SaaS item.

SaaS is a software as a service or a cloud service offering sold by a Charge Metric for a Subscription Period as an OEM Service.

Subscription Period is the time period during which SaaS is available to Customer.

Terms of Use are the OEM's terms of use, terms of service, or similar agreement which sets forth the terms and conditions for Customer's usage of each SaaS item. A SaaS item's Terms of Use are available at the applicable OEM's website.
